Spinners Take On the Pro's

The Spinners, probably America's longest-lived and most successful soul music group, play basketball with the pros, talk about ghetto life, and perform a variety of songs from their unbroken string of hits on **SOUNDSTAGE**, tonight at 10:00 on Channel 4 over PBS. Formed in Detroit in the early '60s, the Spinners have fused their dynamic combination of moving ensemble vocals and tight, smooth choreography for an impressive track record of successful discs and live appearances. Songs like "It's a Shame," "One of a Kind,"

"Could It Be I'm Falling in Love," "Ghetto Child," "Mighty Love," and "Then Came You" (with Dionne Warwick) have catapulted the Spinners to international recognition. These songs, plus more recent hits like "Rubber Band Man," "Games People Play" and "Sadie" are performed on the group's **SOUNDSTAGE** hour.

The program also features the group in two filmed segments. In the first, the Spinners, all avid basketball buffs, scrimmage with the Chicago Bulls basketball team.

Dino's Special Has All-Star Cast

The music, fashions, and humor of the mid-1920s will all be featured on Dean Martin's first special of the season, "Dean Martin's Red Hot Scandals of 1926," Monday, Nov. 8 (10-11 p.m. NYT; 8-9 p.m. PT).

Appearing with Dean are Jonathan Winters, Dom DeLuise, Abe Vigoda, Hermione Baddeley, Georgia Engel, Charlene Ryan and the Goldiggers.

Martin's musical numbers include "Ain't We Got Fun," "All I Do Is Dream Of You," "I Can't Give You Anything But Love," "The Best Things In Life Are Free" and "Now's the Time to Fall In Love."

Georgia Engel and Charlene Ryan join Dean in a spoof of radio jingles; Georgia and Charlene do "Shakin' the Blues Away"; Dean and Hermione appear

in a skit, "It Had to Be You"; and Winters does impressions of Babe Ruth and Charles Lindbergh.

Other selections scheduled for the entire cast include: "Doing the Raccoon," "Puttin' On the Ritz," "Happy Days are Here Again" and a Broadway melody finale. Also "The Man I Love" (Charlene and Vigoda), "Wanting You" (Martin and DeLuise), "When You're Smiling" (Martin), "Diga Diga Doo" (Charlene), "Nagasaki" (Dom) and "Jada" (Georgia). There are songs and sketches about Chicago and a skit about the first talkie featuring Dean, Dom, Abe and Hermione.

Greg Garrison is executive producer of the special; Garrison and Robert Sidney directed. Lee Hale is the producer; the script is by Mike Marmer and Stan Burns.
